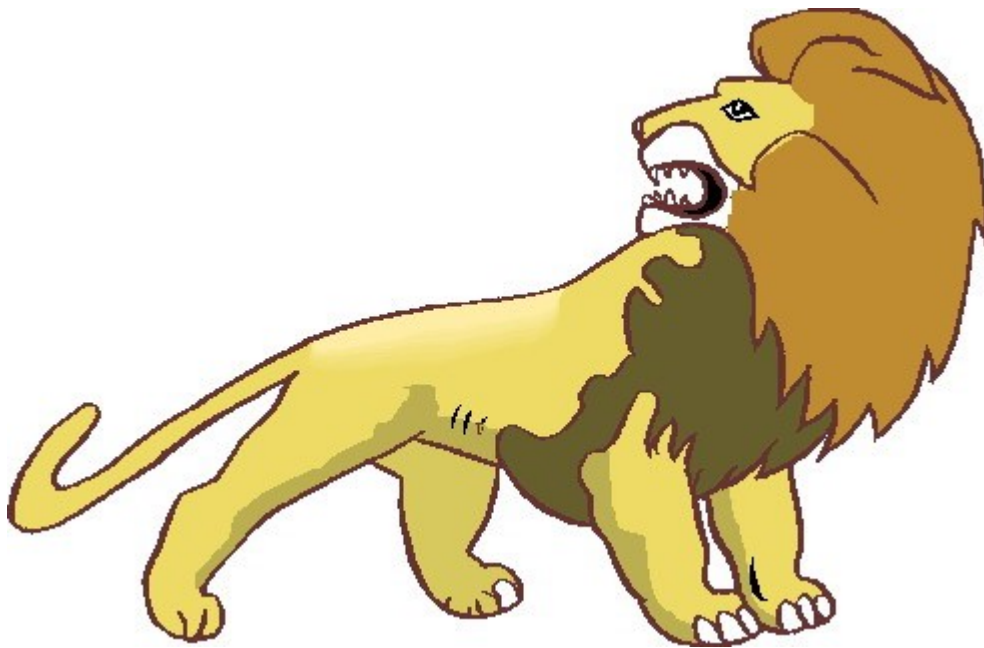

## Mundane Happenings in the Medieval World

### Irish Medieval History as Experienced by the Arthur Family

In Limerick City, Ireland there is a shopping center called Arthur's Quay, which stands on the site of a block of Georgian terraced homes built in the 18th century by the Arthur family.

The Arthur family has a long history with Limerick. Here's a brief bit of the family's medieval history: The first Arthurs came to Ireland in 1170 and just eight years later King Henry II gave Thomas Arthur an estate in Emly, Co. Limerick. By the 13th century the Arthurs established themselves as a prominent merchant family. By the end of the 13th century Limerick was granted the right to elect a mayor on an annual basis and from 1365 to 1635 a members of the Arthur clan held the seat 58 times. Two members of the family served as Bishops of Limerick. In the Hunt Museum in Limerick, The Arthur Chalice and Arthur Crucifix are on display, both belonging to Bishop Richard Arthur.

Nicholas Arthur was the mayor of Limerick seven times as well as a merchant exporting goods to England. One day in 1428 his ship was seized by Breton pirates. He was held captive for two years until a ransom was paid. Once set free he successfully petitioned King Henry VI of England for the right to seize good and property of Frenchmen on land or sea to recover his financial losses.
