

Lesser Known Castles of Ireland

This castle located in the seaside town of Ballybunion, County Kerry Ireland, was built in the 1500s by the Fitzmaurices, Lords of Kerry. The castle was a four story tower house. The Fitzmaurices placed the Bunyan Family in the castle as caretakers. The castle was attacked in 1582 and 1583 and William Og Bunyan had his lands confiscated because of his role in the Desmond Rebellion. By 1960 the castle was sold to the Kerry County Council. In the winter of 1998 the castle was hit by lightening and the upper part of the tower was destroyed. In 2012 the discovery of underground tunnels suggested the existence of an early Christian site.
