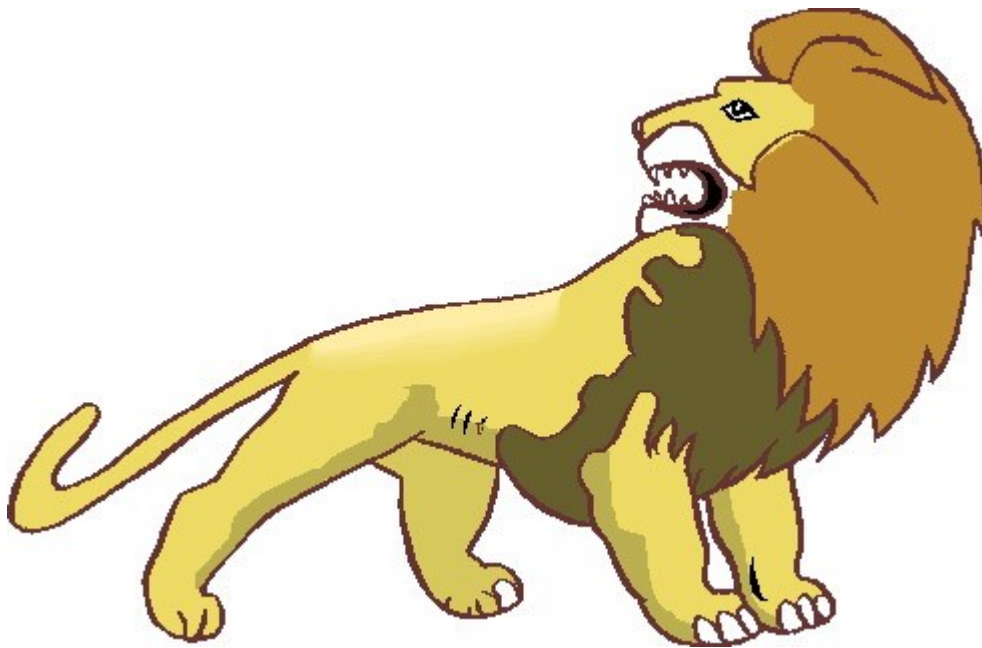

Mundane Happenings in the Medieval World

According to an article published on the January 4, 2017 Independent's newspaper website a lost medieval city has been discovered on the border between England and Wales.

The story began in 2002 when a farmer showed pottery pieces to the Monmouth Archeologic Society that were dug up on the property by moles. Stuart Wilson, then an archaeology grad student, decided to look at the land and found what he believed to be the remains of the wall. Wilson brought the property 13 years ago because he believed that the wall could belong to the lost city of Trellech.

After spending years on the dig, eight buildings have been found including a manor house. Wilson believes town he discovered was founded by the DeClare family in the 13th century.

The site is located near the modern day village of Trellech in Monmouthshire, Wales.
