

Castles of Ireland

Bunratty



The first settlement to occupy Bunratty's Castle site was a Norsemen trading camp that was destroyed by Brian Boru in 977.

In 1251 King Henry III of England granted the lands to Robert DeMuscegros who constructed a motte and bailey castle. Then the king gave the land to Thomas DeClare, a descendant of Strongbow in 1276. DeClare built the first stone structure on the site. The current structure was completed in 1425 by the McNamaras. 50 years later the castle fell to the O'Brien Clan.

In 1956 the 7th Viscount Gort purchased the castle and restored it. In 1960 it opened as a tourist attraction.

The castle is located in Bunratty Village in Co. Clare, not far from Shannon Airport.
