

Mundane Happenings in the Medieval World

Medieval German Woman Found with Blue Plaque on Her Teeth

The New Year started off with this story with bite: a woman's skeletal remains from medieval Germany was found to contain a blue pigment in her dental plaque. The pigment was ultramarine, which is made from crushed lapis lazuli. The woman is believed to have been between the ages 45-60 and lived sometime between 997-1162.

"Based on the distribution of the pigment in her mouth, we concluded that the most likely scenario was that she was herself painting with the pigment and licking the end of the brush while painting," said Monica Tromp, microbioarchaeologist at the Max Planck Institute for the Science of Human History. Ms. Tromp was a co-author of the study that was published in the journal *Science Advances*.

The discovery is groundbreaking because it breaks the stereotype that only monks illustrated manuscripts.
