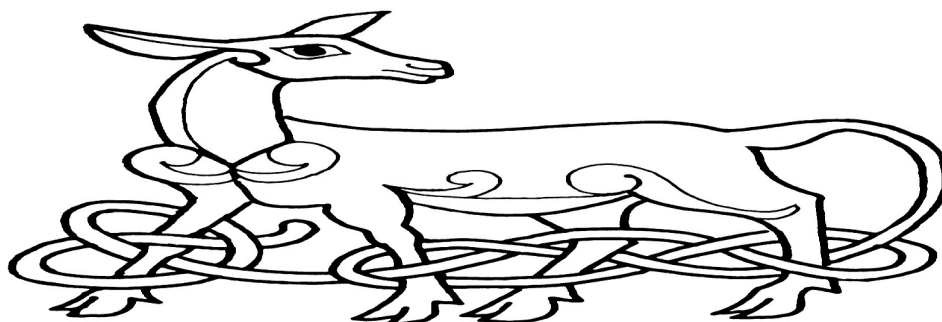

Viking Boat Burials Discovered in Sweden

Speaking of Vikings, on July 5 CNN reported on its website that two rare Viking boat graves were discovered in the Swedish village of Gamla Uppsala. One of the boats held the remains of a man, a dog and a horse. Also found were a sword, an ornate comb, a spear and part of a shield. These finds are rare because most people of the time were cremated with boat burials being reserved for the elite.

The other boat didn't survive as well and it is thought it was damaged during work on the land in the 16th century.

So far only 10 other boat burial sites have been found in Sweden. This type of burial was generally used in the Vendel Period, from about A.D. 550 to 800, and the Viking Age, from about A.D. 800 to 1050.
