

700 Year Old Coronation Chair Undergoing Restoration for Prince Charles' Coronation


CNN"s website on March 1 reported that staff at Westminster Abbey is working on restoring Britain's Coronation Chair for Prince Charles's Coronation on May 6.

The chair was commissioned by Edward 1 around 1300 to house the Stone of Scone, which he captured in 1296.(The stone is back in Scotland)

Krista Blessley, the abbey's paintings conservator, is giving the chair a a surface cleaning with sponges and cotton swabs to remove ingrained dirt. She is also stabilizing surviving layers of the gilding.
