Medieval Grave Unearthed in Poland

The website, Archeology, reports that a medieval grave has been unearthed in northern Poland. The grave contained two identical amber rings, two coins, a bronze bowl, and an iron knife in a leather sheath with bronze fittings. According to Jerry Sikora of the University of Lodz, "The deceased was most likely a representative of local, Pomeranian elites." The grave is located in an area of Poland that is believed to have been a trading center between the eleventh and fourteenth centuries.
