

Cemetery Unearthed at Medieval Monastery In England


The September 4, 2023 on line edition of Newsweek magazine reports on the discovery of a cemetery with 50 bodies at Cookham, England.

The monastery thrived during the eighth and nineth centuries and was under the control of a an Anglo-Saxon queen named Cynethryth. She was married to King Offa, who ruled Mercia.

The bodies discovered span three generations and are of men, women and children. Evacuations also uncovered a walled monastic enclosure and a well with a preserved wooden barrel-lined shaft that contained other wooden artifacts.
