

Centuries Old Prosthetic Hand Discovered in Germany

On November 3, 2023, Smithsonian Magazine reported that a skeleton had been discovered near St. George parish church in the Bavarian town of Freising. The skeleton belongs to a man believed to be between 30 and 50 years old and who died between 1450 and 1620. Parts of the fingers on the left hand were missing.

"The hollow prosthetic on the left hand replaced four fingers," says Walter Irlinger, deputy of the general conservator at the Bavarian State Office for Monument Preservation, in the statement. "The index, middle, ring and pinky fingers are individually formed out of sheet metal and are immobile."

Scans revealed that the prosthetic had scraps of fabric and leather stuck to the metal fingers. Meaning it was possible that the fingers once had a leather cover and were tied to the person's hand using scraps. A gauze like material was found inside the fingers, which might have served as a cushion to prevent the skin from contacting with the metal.
